Short-Term Program Agreement

We, the student and/or his/her natural parents, if the student is under the age of 18, certify that we have received or downloaded the Starr Home Guidelines document and that we have read, understood and intend to comply with the rules outlined therein. We understand that violation of the program rules could result in reduced services and/or the student's dismissal from the program for immediate return to his/her country of origin. There shall be no refund of program fees if a student is dismissed early from the program due to unacceptable behavior.

Appropriate attire including closed-toe shoes, modest apparel and modest swimwear, as outlined in the Starr Home Guidelines document, is required for participation in some activities and events. There shall be no refund if the student is unable to participate in an activity or event due to lack of appropriate attire. There shall be no refund if the student chooses not to participate in a scheduled event or activity, or if the student is not physically capable of participation.

Mutual Friends Student Exchange, Inc. shall be responsible for the student's customary care from the time of the student's pick-up at the designated airport upon arrival until the time student's drop-off at the airport for return home. This includes domestic U.S. transportation, room and board at the Starr Home or in another approved host home, admission to selected events and sights and tuition for the students enrolling in our English Program.

Extraneous costs beyond the customary care of the student shall be the responsibility of the student and/or his/her natural parents. Such expenses include, but are not limited to:

- Transportation costs for pick-up or drop-off at an airport other than Harrisburg International Airport (MDT)
- Souvenirs, snacks, student purchases of any sort
- Student medical treatment costs that are not covered by the student's insurance, such as deductibles or co-pays
- Legal liabilities incurred by the student due to violation of the law
- Any additional transportation costs incurred due to the student's early dismissal from the program due to unacceptable behavior

No student shall travel for participation in any MFSE program until written consent is received from MFSE. Written consent will be granted upon receipt of all necessary paperwork, verification of medical insurance and payment. Any student traveling without consent will not be met at the airport.
